## Safeguarding & Protecting Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy

The Association recognise the need to have systems in place that will ensure that children, young people, and vulnerable adults can work and learn with members of the Association in a safe and fun environment. The Association will adopt and follow the procedures laid out in the Angling Development Board "Safeguarding & Protecting Children Policy" (A copy of which is available from the Anglers Trust) to ensure that they are not putting members in and 'At Risk' position.

All members who will work on a 1-2-1 situation with children, young people or vulnerable adults will be required to undertake a Criminal Records Bureau check and follow a recruitment and induction process.
