Cornish sea trip comes close to tragic ending as angler is...

Savaged by five-foot shark!

THREE county lads' Cornish sharking trip came close to ending in tragedy – when one was savaged by a five-foot blue!

Andy Cottrell suffered severe lacerations as the writhing predator – which he had been trying to unhook for his mate – locked onto his calf and continued thrashing around...

Following emergency treatment on the boat, he

fished on to land a seven-foot 90-pounder, and was taken to A&E when they got back ashore.

The 51 year-old shopfitter said: "It took a lot of tissue off my leg, there was blood everywhere, and it really hurt...but I didn't want to spoil the trip for others by turning back early."

Town sharker Jim Martin (who also had a 90lb+ blue) saw the incident from another boat, and said: "Andy ANOTHER 90lb Cornish blue for town

and said: "Andy was told by the Plymouth hospital that he was only the 14th angler recorded as a shark-bite victim in the UK."

The sharks were all returned alive and Andy is back at work...but faces several weeks of follow-up treatment.
