Planned restoration of Bradwell Lake's access road and car parks is set to start Monday August 21st and finish Friday 25th if all goes to schedule.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disruption to access. People will need to give way to the contractors when necessary, but it has to be worth any minor hassle to get rid of the potholes – and we hope everyone (well, being realistic, most) will be pleased with the results.

The work is being carried out with help of a £5,000 grant from the Environment Agency (rod licence money) allocated under an Angling Trust fishery access improvement scheme.

This follows a £5,000 grant from the same source last year toward the initial stocking of Ashlands.

Thank you the EA and Angling Trust...and all the people who buy rod licences!

There may also be opportunity to carry out other minor works (perhaps such as peg repairs) at the same time, and again we ask people to give the contractors room to get on with the job.

This work follows on from extensive tree surgery/shrubbery control earlier in the year as part of MKAA's continuing improvement of this wholly-owned fishery.
