The invasive alien predator has spread southwards from the Braunston area over a number of years, coinciding with a sharp decline in silverfishing – and it is estimated that the tonne of Zs removed would have already eaten at least two-tonnes of prey fish...if not more.

The on-going work seems to be impacting on the southwards spread. This time the greater numbers, and highest average sizes, were taken from lengths north of Blisworth tunnel.


Though not universally popular, the electrofishing is supported and part-funded by tenant clubs and individuals keen to restore the canal's historic silverfishing potential.
