WITH the team scoring win after win on the bream water, Ferry Meadows ought to be re-named The Ringers' Money-Box!


This weekend it was Phil Ringer, topping the Peterborough Feedermaster final to pocket a grand for weighing in 49-2 of slabs on the tip.
