Cut back to its glory days!

OVES to bring local canal fishing back to its heydays entered a new phase this week – with 350lb of silvers being added.

skimmers and perch going in at Stoke bottom lock, Friday.

And that's intended to be only the start, with thousands more set to be shipped in as available to boost stocks especially the roach population through Nene's holding and south to Leighton Buzzard.

The Canal River Trust's fisheries flagship 'roach restoration' project, underway for three years and continuing, has seen thousands of zander removed, with over a tonne electro-fished out in the latest sweep (some 200 Zs around Castlethorpe marina alone).

Now silvers are being added to jump-start stocks help decimated by the invasive, predatory, alien Zs.

The silvers are coming from currently UNRENTED sections,

further north, to areas such as this where clubs pay to rent the fishing.

CRT national fisheries officer John Ellis said: "It is NOT just about reducing zander biomass, but about increasing the silverfish biomass, too."

- Talks are also underway to attract one, perhaps two, 'nationals' to a revitalised cut in the not too distant future.
